UEFA Champions League 2025-2027

Dear Sir or Madam,

Union des Associations Européennes de Football ("**UEFA**") is the official body for European football responsible to its members for the governing of the sport of football in Europe in accordance with UEFA's statutes and technical rules and for the sanctioning and staging of certain football matches including the UEFA Champions League ("**UCL**"). UEFA holds all worldwide promotional, advertising, broadcasting, marketing and other rights to the UCL.

UEFA Club Competitions SA (trading as UC3) ("**UC3**") is the joint venture company between UEFA and European Football Clubs (formerly known as European Club Association (ECA)) responsible for managing the commercial and business aspects of the UEFA club competitions (including, in particular, their respective commercial programmes and the management, marketing, sales, contracting and delivery of rights).

UC3 hereby confirms that:

- (a) Haleon Consumer Healthcare SARL ("**Company**") has been appointed by UC3 as an official licensee of the UCL under the "*Voltaren*", "*Volarol*", "*VoltaHeat*", "*VoltaMed*", "*Voltacool*" and "*Voltadol*" brands for the 2025/26 and 2026/27 seasons;
- (b) pursuant to the relevant licence agreement, the Company is granted the right to produce, distribute and sell the following topical pain relief products:
 - (i) medicated products, being gels, heat patches, cooling sprays and medical plasters; and
 - (ii) non-medicated products, being gels, heat patches, cooling sprays and medical plasters,in each case solely in the territories and for the seasons set out below:
 - (i) in relation to season 2025/26 and in relation to medicated products only: Germany, France, Netherlands, Belgium, Hungary, Czechia and Slovakia;
 - (ii) in relation to season 2026/27 and in relation to medicated products only: Germany, France, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Netherlands, Belgium, Poland, Hungary, Spain, Czechia and Slovakia; and
 - (iii) in relation to season 2026/27 and in relation to non-medicated products only: Germany, France, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Netherlands, Belgium, Poland, Hungary, Spain, Czechia and Slovakia;
- (c) the Company has the right to use, subject to the provisions of such agreement and applicable law, certain official UCL logos, trade marks and other artwork (including trophy images): (i) in relation to non-medicated products, on such products as well as the associated advertising and promotional materials and product packaging; and (ii) in relation to medicated products, on the associated advertising and promotional materials only.

These rights have been granted to the Company in respect of the period 14 January 2026 to 30 June 2027.

This letter is provided for the sole purpose of enabling the exercise of the abovementioned rights and must not be used for any other purposes. This letter does not grant to the Company any additional rights in respect of the UCL, UC3 and/or UEFA.
